**** *Newcomb Friends Past and Present, Near and Far*** contributed by Marvin Bissell /The Esther Huestis 92, obituary in Post Star is the wife and mother of Richard and 3 kids who drowned in 1959 and are buried in Newcomb cemetery. Richard was brother to Majorie Tefoe , Mildred Tefoe Duval, and Alice Schraver. Eight of them went out on Efner Lake near Corinth, in a home made rowboat and only the father and one son could swim. The father saved some of them but when he went for another, he drowned also. They were laid out in Marjorie's house, where Goulet's house is now and I was a pall bearer. Esther was buried in Newcomb cemetery on Wednesday./ /The obituary in 26 May issue of the Post Star doesn't mention Newcomb but Laurie Gregory grew up here and attended NCS.. She lived a little ways in on the Goodnow Road with her parents Bill and Helen. Bill worked in Tahawus before the mines closed and Helen drove school bus if I remember right. They are buried in Newcomb cemetery. A recent storm knocked the wires down at a house near where Laurie lived onto the meter box and somehow put high voltage in the house wiring. Most of the electronic items in the house started smoking until they were unplugged and thrown outside. Including a computer and accessories, 2 tv sets, a microwave, a phone, etc.. The electric meter was going around at hyper speed. Wait until they get their electric bill ! A man said the storm knocked down a hundred trees on his land and a couple places looked like mico-bursts. I never heard of such a thing in Newcomb until the last few years. I never saw so much water around here either especially after the snow is all gone. Arlene West of the same paper, wasn't a native of Newcomb, but she was a sister of Craig Plumley who ran the diner, last in Newcomb. She was also related to the West's and Parker's of Newcomb./
