The activities that will result in a revised and updated Newcomb Comprehensive Plan are well underway. One significant item is the mailing of the Survey of Town Residents. This was mailed on March 27th to all people of the Town Tax Rolls. Others who wish to participate may download a copy of the Survey from the website, fill it in and mail it to the Chazen Company at the address given.

The Survey is a primary way for residents (both year round and seasonal) to provide input to the Comprehensive Plan. The Committee is hoping for a large percentage of residents responding, providing their thoughts, opinions, and ideas. Your input is important so take a few minutes to fill out the form, adding any appropriate comments and suggestions, and send it in. Failure to do so could result in your good ideas from being heard and incorporated.

Mark June 18th on your calendar. On this date, at 7 PM in the Newcomb Central School Auditorium, an [open meeting](#) will be held to review the Planning Process and to gather additional comments and ideas. The larger the turnout, the better the Plan will be. All inputs are welcome and need to be heard.
